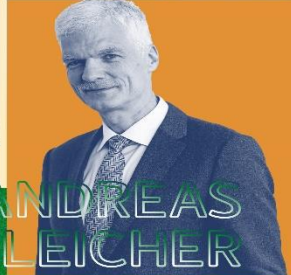
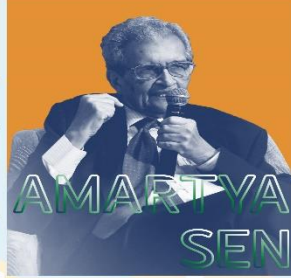

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مقدمه :

در 30 سال از اعلامیه جهانی آموزش برای همه (اعلامیه جامتین ، تایلند) ، جهان در دستیابی به هدف جهانی آموزش گامهای بلندی برداشته است. جذب کودکان در مدارس در مناطق در حال توسعه در سال 2015 به 91 درصد و تعداد کودکان خارج از مدرسه تقریباً نیمی کاهش یافته است. با این حال ، اختلافات و تبعیض های بزرگی همچنان در حوزه برابری دسترسی به آموزش باقی مانده است. کودکان فقیر تا پنج برابر بیشتر از افراد ثروتمند در خارج از مدرسه باقی مانده اند و دسترسی کمتری به آموزش دارند. تفاوت ها بین مناطق روستایی و شهری همچنان زیاد است . از آنجا که نابرابری آموزش به دلیل بیماری همه گیر COVID-19 بیشتر از گذشته جهان و حوزه آموزش را تهدید می کند و تنها 10 سال از رسیدن به اهداف توسعه پایدار (SDG) باقی مانده است، اکنون ، بیش از هر زمان دیگر ، زمان آن رسیده است که جهانیان گرد هم آیند و به تغییر از طریق راه حل های نوآورانه و پایدار سرعت بیشتری ببخشند.

کنفرانس الکترونیکی دو روزه تحت عنوان یکپارچه " همه برای آموزش یا بسیج تمام امکانات برای آموزش برابر " 10 - 11 ژوئیه 2020 ، با استفاده از ابزار تکنولوژی ویدیو آنلاین انجام گردید و از طریق چندین کانال با خدمات پخش عمومی و رایگان تایلند (TPBS) به عنوان یکی از شرکای اصلی در این همایش ، پخش شد . این کنفرانس این امکان را برای مردم از سراسر جهان فراهم کرد . تا در مورد نابرابری در آموزش و کاهش تفاوت های بین دانش آموزان در جهان بحث شده و راه حل های آن را بررسی گردد. کنفرانس الکترونیکی به ریاست شاهزاده خانم کشور تایلند والا مقام Maha Chakri Sirindhorn ، به عنوان سکوی پرتابی برای برجسته کردن راه حل های نوآورانه ، تبادل شیوه های خوب و آموخته های آموخته شده و همچنین تقویت حرکت برای دستیابی به عدالت در آموزش برای همه کودکان صرف نظر از ثروت ، درآمد ، قدرت یا دارایی به اجرا در آمد.

کنفرانس الکترونیکی بیش از 20 جلسه (پنل) تخصصی توسط پیشروان و متخصصان برجسته آموزش جهانی ارائه شد. دفاتر نمایندگی سازمانهای بین المللی و وزارت آموزش تایلند بصورت حضوری و مهمانان بیش از 30 کشور دنیا بصورت مجازی از طریق ویدئو کنفرانس در این کنفرانس شرکت کردند که بیش از 60 شخصیت و متخصص بین المللی بعنوان سخنران در حداقل 5 نشست اصلی و 20 جلسه و پنل تخصصی به ارایه سخنرانی و تجربیات خود در زمینه برابری در آموزش پرداختند.


